Background

The Bingley Bubble Community Partnership supports the communities and patients served by Baildon Medical Practice, Bingley Medical Practice, Oak Glen Surgery, Springfield Surgery and Wilsden Medical Practice (including Cullingworth Medical Practice) - and has a presence in one of the Bradford localities (Shipley).

We are the community partnership lead or joint lead for the following wards (where there are the highest numbers of Bingley Bubble PCN registered patients):

- Bingley
- Bingley Rural
- Baildon (joint CP lead with WISHH CP)

Bingley Bubble CP expects to allocate in the region of £15000 for small grants in 2023/24. This is funded by Bradford District & Craven Health & Care Partnership.

Grants of £500 and over are available for groups or individuals who can deliver project work relating to one or more of the priorities below within one or more parts of the Bingley Bubble CP area. Please note our grants are typically up to a maximum of £2000.

Criteria for grant applications

- Groups or individual applying for a grant should have a base or be able to operate within the Bingley Bubble Community Partnership area
- Grants cannot be awarded for retrospective payments (events/purchases that have already taken place)
- Applications towards the cost of refurbishments of buildings or capital building costs will not be considered
- Groups / organisations should normally only expect the maximum of one grant per financial year
- Grants cannot be used to fund political or religious activities
- Applications for school curricular related activities will not be funded
- Failure to fully complete the application form with all required information will result in delay to consideration of the application or its rejection but please contact us (details below) if you need help or support with the application process
- Please note that some of the data collected as part of this funding bid will be shared with members of the community partnership and external partners

Application process

Bingley Bubble CP will fund at least one small grant funding round in 2023/24. Should the grant budget not be fully allocated in this first round, or if further funding become available, we may run a second round. We also intend to run a small grants process in subsequent years.

The deadline for applications for 2023/24 Bingley Bubble CP small grants is 30th November 2023

Applications will be considered by the Bingley Bubble CP leadership team during week commencing 11th December 2023

Grant management and monitoring

• A memorandum of understanding for small grants will be signed and returned by grant recipients prior to invoices for project funding being paid

- Monitoring arrangements and timescales will be agreed on a case-by-case basis for each project with the Community Health and Wellbeing Coordinator and Project Manager and are intended to be light touch and proportionate
- As a minimum, a short report (which could be in video form) will be required at the end of the project
- You may also be invited to present on your project at the Bingley Bubble CP Leadership Team meeting.
- Bingley Bubble Community Partnership and Bradford District Health & Care Partnership shall be identified in any publicity relating to activities funded by the grant; logos will be provided
