- a) Dr Wei Deng explained that the purpose of the Design Code is to improve the area around the town centre to make a high-quality public realm that is more pedestrian and cyclist friendly with improved links to green spaces. A discussion was held about the document. The Neighbourhood Plan Working Group suggested the following
 - Include another map showing the wider area and including village centre 'bubbles'
 - Add more detail at 4.5 about what features could be included
 - Emphasize suggestions about making Main Street more pedestrian and cyclist friendly
 - Encourage tall and heavy loads to use the bypass
 - Request amendments are made to the document to reflect the discussion

Councillor Simpson left the meeting at 8.04pm

b) Dr Wei Deng advised that the feedback previously provided will be addressed and typos corrected.

Large areas of countryside have not been included in the Masterplan as changes are not proposed. He explained the reasoning for identifying the Swan Avenue parade as a local centre, this can be accessed on foot by residents of both Eldwick and Gilstead within 10 minutes. This could be titled an 'enhanced local centre' in the document and be accompanied by a list of specific ideas for enhancement and safer connections.

Improvements for Cottingley and Micklethwaite were discussed, particularly relating to pedestrian and cycle routes linking the villages to the rest of the parish.

Councillor Clough left the meeting at 8.15pm

The Neighbourhood Plan Working Group suggested the following amendments to the Masterplan

- Look at how the Swan Avenue parade area can be enhanced to make stronger links with both Eldwick and Gilstead, without any detriment to Eldwick or Gilstead. Include a list of potential enhancements.
- Include stronger pedestrian and cycle routes throughout
- Strengthen suggestions for Micklethwaite in the Masterplan by giving it a number on the map at 5.1 in order to protect the character of the village, adding cycle routes and providing a statement about including pedestrian and cycle routes around the Sty Lane development.
- If traffic is encouraged to use the bypass to include measures to improve air quality and noise abatement
- To extend the study area as discussed
- To improve Wellington Street and the area around Foundry Hill to encourage more traffic to use this route and reduce use of the main street, linking to the aim of making the town center more pedestrian and cycle friendly.
- c) The Neighbourhood Plan Working Group will send a copy of the relevant comments from BMDC to AECOM. A further meeting may be arranged once the comments have been reviewed by AECOM, if required.

Councillor Dawson thanked the representatives from AECOM for their work on the documents and for attending the meeting.
