- a) The amended Housing Chapter was received. Ms Gibbons had added a statement on flooding and had amended references to the AECOM Housing Needs assessment. Councillor Dawson raised an issue with Policy H6 in the chapter and following discussion the Neighbourhood Plan

Working Group **resolved** to make a further amendment before recommending the chapter to the Planning Committee. Policy H6 is to read 'all new homes built in the Bingley parish should be energy efficient and endeavour to exceed building regulations and meet building standards set by the Association for Environment Conscious Builders, or similar'.

Councillor Williams advised that the Policies Chapter will also require updating.

b) Subject to this amendment the Neighbourhood Plan Working Group **resolved** to recommend the chapter to the Planning Committee for approval.

The Planning Committee has previously approved an application to Locality for the outstanding grant amount and an amount will be included in the Town Council budget for 2021-2022.
- b) Andrew Towlerton Associates have advised that they will liaise with BMDC with the view that the Bingley Parish Neighbourhood Plan, when completed, doesn't require an SEA but that if BMDC require an SEA that it is conducted by BMDC. The Neighbourhood Plan Working Group received and accepted this advice.
- c) The plan for topics at meetings was considered and will be reviewed going forward.

The group considered that it may wish to approach schools to engage with younger members of the community at an early
