## **Litter Education**

# 1718/24 Events

- 1. Bulb planting events 19<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> October. These are taking place as planned.
- 2. Litter pick 12<sup>th</sup> November. Chris Slaven is to be asked about security issues for litter picking for this Remembrance event.
- 3. Litter pick dates 2018. Suggested dates are 10<sup>th</sup> February 2018, 14<sup>th</sup> April 2018, 9<sup>th</sup> June 2018, 11<sup>th</sup> August 2018, 13<sup>th</sup> October 2018 and 8<sup>th</sup> December 2018.
- 4. Follow up from forum on 9<sup>Th</sup> September 2017. The Bradford Council grot spot scheme does not operate now. Councillor Simpson will follow up the reported issue of impassable paths and vandalized picnic tables at Bingley South Bog and will check with Bradford Council if perennials can be bought at a discount.
- 5. Next forum, January 2018 and speaker on "In Bloom". The date is to be 13<sup>th</sup> January 2018 and Mike Cunningham from the In-Bloom organization has been invited along to the forum.

# 1718/25 Planting plans

- 1. Update on winter planting plans. Bulbs are being delivered w.c. 16<sup>th</sup> October 2017. Councillor Goode will liaise with Councillor Hardman about the delivery of the remaining bulbs and plants
- 2. Summer 2018 planting plans and sponsorship. Subject to full council approval, there is to be a repeat of the current planting scheme with some enhancements. Sponsorship is being investigated with the potential of twenty businesses sponsoring twenty baskets etc. The council will need to obtain some separate specialist VAT advice.

# 1718/26 Green and Clean 2018 budget

The current proposal is for a budget of £19,000 for the Green and Clean work 2018 -2019.

# 1718/27 Follow up from resident issues raised at the last meeting

- 1. Cottingley Fun Day. Bradford Council is considering the purpose-built cycle track suggested by a local resident.
- 2. Bins/littering on Park Road. Councillor Simpson had requested the reinstatement of a missing bin on August 27<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. Poster removal after events. The Bradford Council Clean Team deal with any posters left by event organisers.
- 4. Overgrown weeds in Cottingley village. Councillor Goode has arranged for the weeds to be cleared.
- 5. Bin at Samuel Lister Academy. This matter has been resolved.

# 1718/28 Progress reports

- 1. Action stations (Bingley and Crossflatts) station adoption. Both groups have appointed their committees. Northern Rail has awarded £500 funding to each group
- 2. Bin mapping in parks. Bradford Council has advised that 5-10 bins in parks are replaced in Shipley each year and some are refurbished. They will note the Town Council request.
- 3. Tree planting, Bingley Rotary club project. Councillor Simpson is waiting for information from the Rotary Club following advice from the Bradford Council Tree Officer..
- 4. Snickets. A survey by Town Councillors mapping all snickets in the parish was suggested.
