

Bingley Public Toilets






Location

Bingley Public Toilets are located in the centre of Bingley. The surrounding area is of mixed use in nature which consists of shops, banks, restaurants and a public pool adjacent to the site. Immediately to the north of the site is a public car park.

The site is currently owned by Bradford City Council, which have ear marked the site for closing down in March 2018.

The topography of the site is relatively level with a slight gradient towards the entrance to the toilets. The building is surrounded by grass with a paved entrance area.



Existing Floor Plan 1:100





Proposed Scheme

This proposed scheme is to provide an office space, meeting room, storage and retain the two existing public toilets to the front of the building.

The scheme also shows the relocation of the plant room central to the two existing public toilets. The existing public toilets entrance to be blocked up and new external semi-automatic entrance doors to be located to the front of the building.
