1	<p><b>Update on Actions from Last Meeting (9<sup>th</sup> April 2018) -</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Action: Cath to inform all which PCSOs will be working with which schools.</u></b></li> <li>• The suggested location for the data-logger on the A629 near to the Flappit is considered to be too near to the bend / junction with Manywells, where vehicles will be slowing down. However there might not be a lamp-post to attach it to further away. <b><u>Action: Wendy to pass on comments to Craig Williams.</u></b></li> <li>• <b><u>Action: Cath to write article on new Neighbourhood Police Team and crime prevention for the village newsletters / websites.</u></b></li> <li>• <b><u>Action: Cath to look into the legality of putting registration numbers onto social media.</u></b> It is thought that registration numbers can be looked up on the DVLA website, to see if a vehicle is taxed / insured, however no names or addresses are given.</li> <li>• <b><u>Action: Cath to obtain feedback on the unsuccessful bid for funding for school parking 'pupil' banners and make further bid.</u></b></li> <li>• <b><u>Action: Cath to book Police Contact Point for Saturday morning drop-in sessions at Wilsden and Denholme.</u></b></li> <li>• <b><u>Action: Wendy to ask Parks &amp; Landscapes Manager about a new bin in the recreation ground, and keep the Village Council informed.</u></b> The Village Council would be prepared to pay for the bin.</li> </ul>

Neighbourhood Watch is very popular on social media now.</li> <li>• Someone has been damaging walls at Lee Lane in Wilsden, pushing stones on to the footway.</li> <li>• Ray has obtained two vehicle registrations in connection with dangerous driving in Wilsden, and will pass these to the Police.</li> <li>• Ann reported that her private driveway is sometimes blocked by parked vehicles at Goit Stock Lane in Harden. The road is unadopted. <b><u>Action: Ann to seek advice on this from the Police, and Wendy to do likewise with the Warden Manager.</u></b></li> </ul>
