Proposal for the Painting of Bingley's Street Furniture

Proposal

The Town Centre and Regeneration Committee have discussed the need to repaint the street Furniture in Bingley and put forward the following for consideration by the Full Council and subsequent approval.

The current colour of the Street Furniture is painted Blue, it's proposed to repaint in Black in keeping with other Street Furniture in the surrounding district (Shipley & Keighley)

For clarity, Street Furniture includes Signs, Lamp Posts, Railings, posts, Bollards, bins, planters and benches, effectively anything that adorns the streets and Highways of Bingley

Area of Consideration

Repainting the Street Furniture located on Keighley Road, from the Parish Church along the Main Street through to the Junction of Ferncliffe. Including a section at the top of Park Rd, Bushfield Street, Wellington Street, Chapel Lane, Waterloo Rd, Midland Hill, Market Street, Queens Street, Airedale Street Myrtle Place and Myrtle Grove. Bradford Council Approved Contractor

In accordance with council guideline, three quotations have to be obtained for works over £500. It would be prudent use the umbrella of Bradford Council, who have gone through the approval process and appointed the below contractor for their Street Furniture painting. Thus avoiding the drawn out and potentially protracted process of obtaining quotations from two other contractors, who will need to gain the approval of Bradford Council and all that involves.

Note: - Bradford awarded the Painting Contract to a Contractor from Sheffield who was unable to fulfil their obligations and as a result forfeited the contract, subsequently awarded to Bagnalls.
